

Hello parents, we are excited to meet your child and provide a wonderful experience for them at the Superior Summer Camp. Below are a few very important things to know; the short version is:

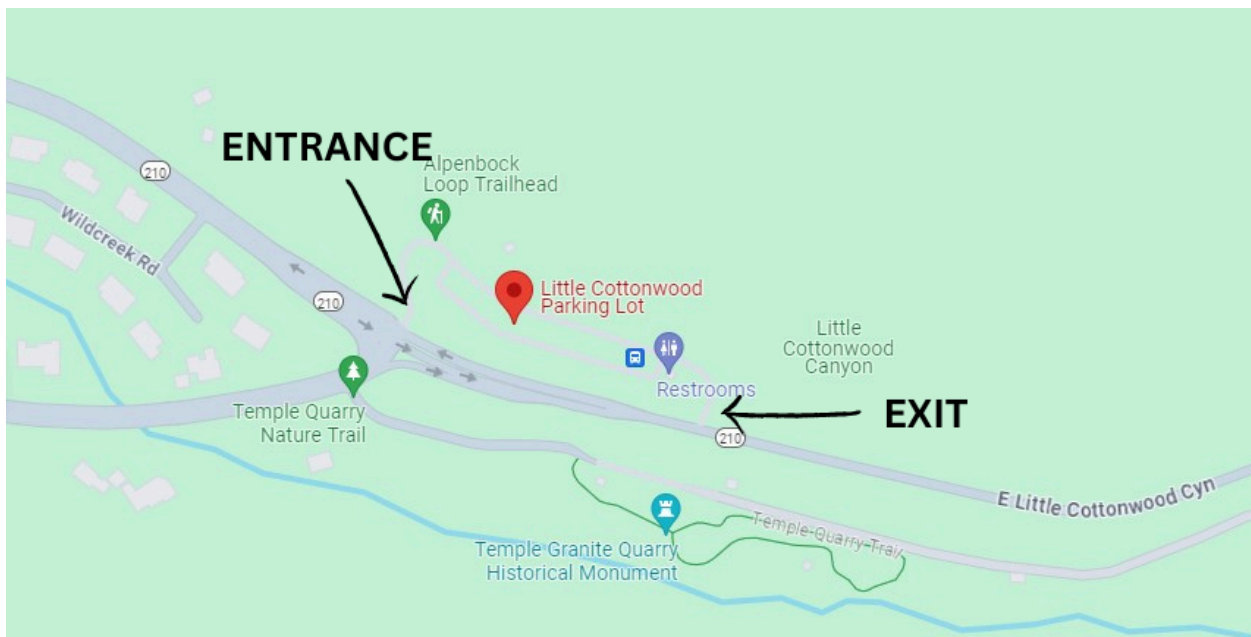
Make sure your invoice is paid via Brightwheel and you know your 4 digit code (this can be found under your parent account).

Bring your kiddo to camp with comfortable tennis shoes and spare clothes in a reusable bag or backpack.

Please make sure you check over your child's paperwork before leaving them on their first day. **If your child has any allergies, disabilities, or medical conditions please reply to this email to let us know as well as talk with the director at check-in. We want to make sure we're all very aware of any extra precautions to keep your kiddo safe and happy!**

The vans depart and arrive on time at the Little Cottonwood Canyon Park and Ride (at the mouth of Little Cottonwood Canyon): **4385 Little Cottonwood Canyon Rd, Sandy, UT, 84092**. It has come to our attention that Apple Maps will take you to the wrong location. Please be sure you are at the Park and Ride at the mouth of the canyon where there is a fork in the road. **Please make sure to use the correct one-way entrance and exit into and out of the Park and Ride parking lot.** See photo below. Please be there nice and early, as we are strict about departure time in the morning and even stricter about pick-ups.

The vans leave the Park and Ride promptly at 8:30am (please arrive between 8:15-8:30am) and arrive at 4:15pm (please arrive between 4:15-4:30pm).

We understand things come up and you may need to contact us outside of camp hours. If you have an emergency situation, you may call Ilse Wilson, the Owner/Director/and active Camp Counselor on her cell phone: (801)702-7004. If you message between 5pm-7am, it will be responded to after 7am as we are clocked out for personal time.

Please update your child's Brightwheel profile picture with a recent photo and add as much info as possible to the app so we have it at our fingertips. The Brightwheel app is how we will check your child in and out at pick-up and drop-off. It will make things run so much better on the first day of camp if you know the 4-digit code that is affiliated with your account.

We will be utilizing the Snowbird Tram during the week and every child must have a liability waiver filled out in order to ride the tram. In order to obtain a waiver from Snowbird, we need a copy of the parent's Full Name, Date of Birth, and Email address. Please reply to this email with the necessary information so we can get your tram account activated and the waiver signed.

We will provide:

- Transportation via large SUVs and 15 passenger vans when needed. All transportation vehicles have identifiable magnets with our Superior Summer Camp logo on it.
- Very yummy, nutritious meals, lots of snacks and drinks. See the [menu](#) on our website.
- Every day a piece of art and/or crafts and even special gifts that we have planned with all the themed projects will be coming home.

Please send your child with:

1. Tennis shoes that are good for both indoor and outdoor play.
2. Pants or shorts, tee shirt, and a jacket.
3. Extra clothes, a pair of socks, and shoes in a bag to switch out in case we get messy during our activities.
4. Their personal water bottle with their name on it!

5. Whatever you would send your kiddo outside to play in (hat, sunscreen, sunglasses, etc).
 - **PS. LABEL, LABEL, LABEL EVERYTHING!!!!** Lost and Found boxes will be at the vans each afternoon, because we know kids get distracted by all the fun we have. **Please check the lost and found at the end of each day!**
6. Feel free to pack additional snacks for your kiddo too.

We always plan on operating according to the schedule posted on our website, spending the majority of our time doing engaging learning and interactive activity workshops and free play, however we take the children's temperament and weather in mind and will follow suit as deemed appropriate.
